
Micropiles (also known as minipiles) are excellent for new construction project with deep foundation requirements. In compression they are used as footers and in tension they may be used to support retaining or foundation walls. Using a hydraulic motor attached to a backhoe or skid steer, the pier (which is essentially a large screw) is drilled into the earth to a specified depth. It is a fast and easy way to install a foundation system.

They are also known for their ability to carry significant loads and for their quick installation.

The **Titan** pile, highlighted to the right, is an example of a commonly used micropile **product**.
